Thank you for supporting the CVHT and Charlotte Pony Club, we look forward to welcoming you to our event.

With current concerns regarding the COVID pandemic, we ask that you adhere to the following requests encompassing USEA and USEF competition guidelines for Covid-19, as well as Charlotte Pony Club and High Wind Farm's rules for all attendees.



Please **stop at the check-in** when you enter High Wind Farm. You will be screened and receive your packet if approved.

There will be a parking attendant to direct you, follow their instructions for parking in order to be able to stay distanced from other trailers.

Face masks must be worn at all times by everyone on grounds unless you are on a horse. Don't make us ask. If you don't feel well, have a fever, or have had within 24 hours, please stay home.

One support person per rider (parent, spouse, groom) may attend, this does NOT include your coach and volunteers. Coaches may stay on property as long as students are competing. **Avoid congregating in groups.**

Plan to remove your pinny at the end of your ride and place it in the labeled bins. Do not wear your pinny back to your trailer.

Consider walking your courses on Saturday if you can. We will be set up and ready at noon on Saturday.

Plan to wipe Port-a-potty doors and other touchable surfaces when done, supplies will be provided.

Bring your own water for horses, for drinking and bathing.

After you're finished, plan to cool off your horse and head for home. Bring a self addressed, stamped envelope for dressage tests and ribbons. Two STAMPS if you want your ribbon. Hand in your envelope at check-in.

Please do not leave trash, hay or manure in the parking field.

If you bring your dog it must be tied or leashed; no dogs allowed on the cross-country course. Clean up after your dog.

There will be a **Silent Auction** table set up under the tent, please take a moment to bid on our items, while maintaining a social distance from others.

Food will be available from the Charlotte Pony Club courtesy of Jess Oppenheimer. There will be coffee, breakfast sandwiches, lunch options, and beverages. Consider supporting our club with a breakfast or lunch purchase!
